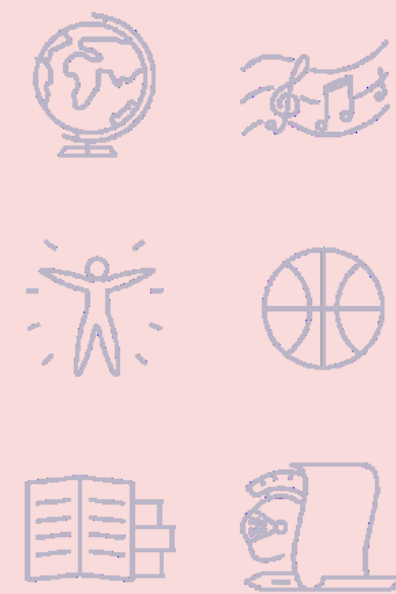

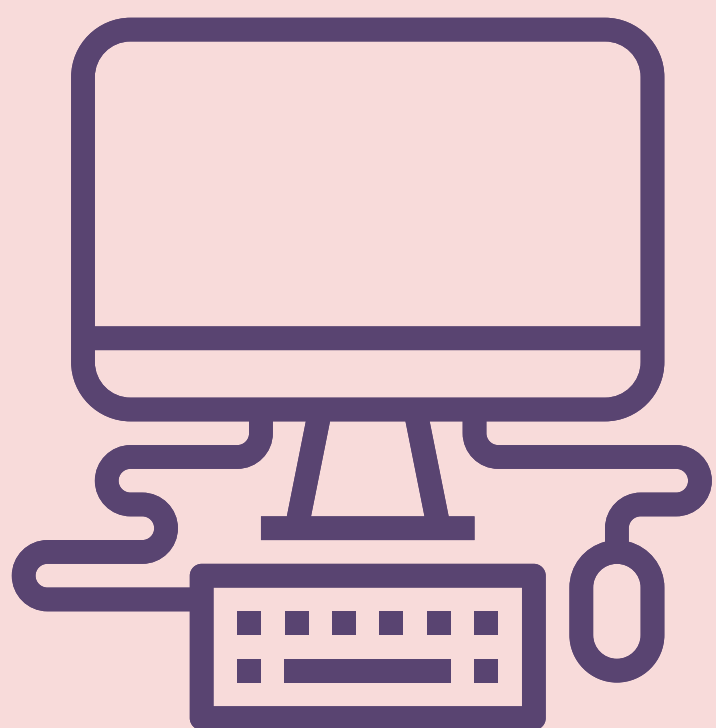

worked more hours than usual



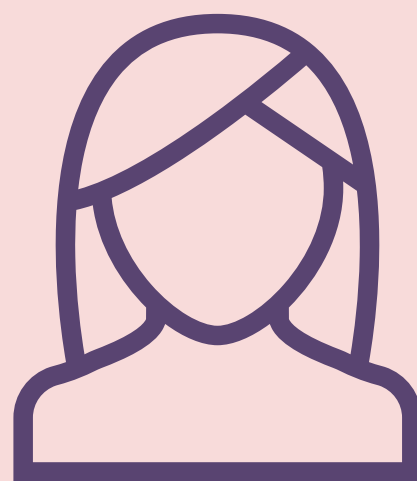
83.0 %

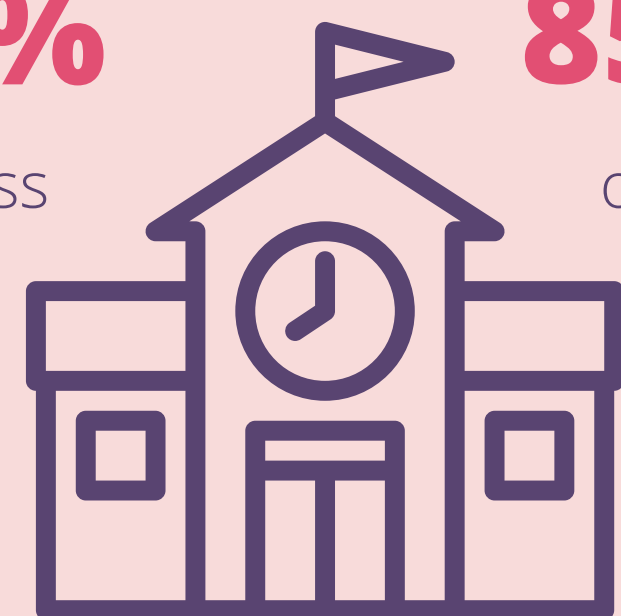

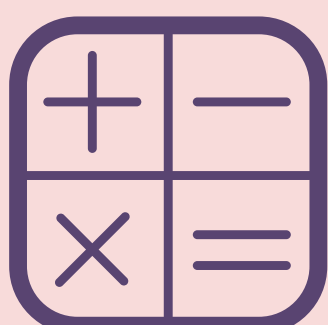
